


<u>Professional G1 – Auto Maintenance and Light Repair Certification Award</u>

New – Students can earn their first professional level ASE Certification! Beginning August 1st, 2024, the ASE Education Foundation has established an exciting new opportunity for students that participate in the ASE Entry-Level Certification testing program:


- School/Program is currently an ASE Accredited Training Program
- Pass (8) specific ASE Entry-Level Certification Tests and
- Submit the eligible work experience (6-months of full-time work or 1-year of part-time work)

Students will automatically receive 6-months towards the required 1 year of work experience requirement and the ASE professional certification in G1 – Maintenance & Light Repair. This award must be claimed through their ASE Entry-Level student dashboard to be activated. The school must have one or more ASE accredited programs and the student's certificate must be printed.

This opportunity is available to all students enrolled in an actively accredited ASE training program who take the ASE Entry-Level Certification tests and successfully pass the *Automobile* series tests in Engine Repair (ER), Automatic Transmission/Transaxle (AT), Suspension & Steering (SS), Brakes (BR), Electrical/Electronic Systems (EE), Heating & Air Conditioning (AC), Engine Performance (EP), Manual Drive Train & Axles (MD).




Once the student successfully passes all (8) tests, allow 24-hours for the system to verify the required tests have been passed and log back in. A message will appear on the student dashboard stating "Congratulations, you have earned new awards!".




Clicking on the message opens the My Awards tab, which shows the earned G1 award. This message will appear for 30 days after the 8th test is passed. After 30 days, the message will no longer appear, but the award will always be available under the "My Awards" tab.


*Note: The school <u>must</u> have one or more ASE accredited programs and the student's certificate must be printed.







The myASE login page will appear. If you already have a myASE account, just log in. If you have not yet created a myASE account (most students do not have a myASE account), click the *Create myASE Account* link at the bottom of the page.

*Note: The student's name must match what is listed on their ASE Entry-Level Student


Dashboard when setting up their myASE account.




Upon completing your first name, last name, date of birth, and last 4 digits of your social security number; click Next. *Note: To claim the G1 award, the name you enter here MUST match the name shown on your ASE Entry-Level dashboard.*




Upon clicking Next, enter your phone number, mailing address, and e-mail address, and create a password. This should be a strong password that is different from your ASE Entry-Level password. Continue by clicking Next.







Next, complete the remaining optional identifying information and click "Submit".




The next page explains that at least 6-months of hands-on work experience must be submitted to become fully ASE certified. If you already have the needed experience, click the first link to read the instructions on completing the work experience report form. Click the second link to complete the form. You don't have to do that right away; you can get work experience later and add it to your myASE profile then. Click the last link to go to your myASE home page.




Congratulations! You created a myASE account and now have your G1 certification in hand. In addition to successfully completing all 8 tests, you also receive half of the work experience requirement to activate the professional level G1 Certification. To activate the new certification, you will need to submit the remaining applicable work experience. Once you submit the work experience information, you will receive a printed certificate and insignia to proudly display. You can return here anytime to add work experience, purchase other professional ASE tests, and view your professional credentials.



Instructors and Administrators will also be able to see which students have met the required criteria and achieved the award. When an instructor is logged into the ASE Entry-Level system and viewing their dashboard, they can click the "Select" button next to any roster(s) listed, including active or inactive rosters, to view any students that have achieved the award. Students that have met the criteria will have an award icon to the right of their name:





This award only appears if the program is currently ASE accredited. Awards are processed overnight, so the notification for students will appear the day after students have passed all 8 required tests. For students to claim their award, students must be logged into their student dashboard and click the "My Awards" tab and click the link. Once they click to claim their award, they will be redirected to myASE to continue the process for logging into their myASE account or creating one. Once they are logged into their myASE account, they will see their G1 – Auto Maintenance and Light Repair certification listed. Students MUST click to claim the award through their Entry-Level account to claim the G1 certification award. For additional information, please read the frequently asked questions below.

Frequently Asked Questions

Students took and passed the required (8) tests before this academic year; will they receive the award?

Yes. Any student that is currently or previously enrolled at an ASE accredited training program and has passed the required tests within the last 2 years has already been granted the award and eligible to claim the G1 Certification. All steps for submitting the required 6-months of work experience must still be followed to activate the certification.

Students took all (8) tests that are required and do not see their award.

It will take up to 24 hours once the 8th test is successfully passed for the award to appear on the student dashboard. Once the student passes the 8th test, they will need to login the next day to see their award.

What tests qualify for the award?

Currently, only the following (8) Automobile Series Tests qualify for the G1 award:

AUTOMOBILE SERIES

- Engine Repair (ER)
- Automatic Transmission/Transaxle (AT)
- Manual Drive Train and Axles (MD)
- Suspension and Steering (SS)
- Brakes (BR)
- Electrical/Electronic Systems (EE)
- Heating and Air Conditioning (AC)
- Engine Performance (EP)

My program is not currently ASE Accredited. Can students still receive the G1 certification award?

No. The G1 certification award requires the program be a currently ASE accredited training program.

How do students submit work experience?

Students will need to login to their ASE Entry-Level Certification account and click the "My Awards" tab on their dashboard. They will then see the explanation for achieving the award and need to click the link to claim the award. Once they claim the award, they will be redirected to myASE where they will either login to their existing myASE account or click "Create myASE account" and proceed through the steps to create an account. Once logged into their myASE account they will be able to enter their work experience details.

^{*}The Automobile Maintenance and Light Repair (MLR) and Automobile Service Technology (AST) tests do **not** qualify towards the G1 Certification award criteria.

What work experience is required?

A total of 6-months of full-time work experience or 1 year of part-time work experience must be submitted. They must be paid employees performing automotive service and repair. Additional work experience qualification details can be found here: <u>ASE Work Experience Details</u>.

How long does it take for work experience to be verified?

It may take up to a maximum of 2 weeks to verify the submitted work experience qualifies.

How long will the student have to meet the work experience requirement once they complete the steps to claim the award and set up their myASE account?

The G1 Certification will be valid for 5 years from the date they complete the 8th test. The student may submit the work experience anytime within the 5 years to receive their ASE certificate and insignia.

Students already have a myASE account. Will the G1 certification award automatically appear in their myASE account?

No. Students <u>MUST</u> click the link to claim the award through their ASE Entry-Level student dashboard so the system can validate the student meets the G1 Certification criteria outlined. When the student claims the award through their ASE Entry-Level dashboard, they will be taken to myASE where they can simply login with their existing credentials and receive the G1 Certification award. If the student does not have an existing myASE account, they will need to click "Create myASE Account" and simply complete the login steps to receive their G1 Certification award.

How long does it take to receive my ASE certificate and insignia once the required work experience is approved?

It may take up to 4 weeks after the required work experience is submitted and approved for students to receive their ASE certificate and insignia.

Does the G1 ASE Certification cost money to receive?

No. There is no money required to receive the G1 Certification Award once the required ASE Entry-Level tests are successfully taken and passed and the program is currently accredited. Taking the required (8) ASE Entry-Level Certification tests does require a seat license, paid for and administered by the student's school.
